Guiding and Instruction in all aspects of Trout Fly Fishing, Salmon and Seatrout Fishing and Fly Dressing

Programme for Saltwater and Streamers – 6th February 2010

The venue will be my house as above. For this reason numbers will be strictly limited to **4 persons** per day. If there is sufficient interest in any of the days then further days can be arranged to suit.

Meet about 9.45am ready to start at 10.00am. We will aim to finish at 4.00pm with a break around 1.00 pm for a quick Ploughman's style lunch. Coffee/tea are provided. There is reasonable lighting in the room so extra lights should not be needed but if you do need one I will do my best to find a suitable power source.

If you have a suitable tying board to clamp your vice on please bring it. If not let me know and I will supply one for the day. Room is limited so if you can travel light it will help.

Below is a basic list of patterns/styles we are going to work towards for the day. I will have sufficient materials for everyone but bring your own tools and materials so that we can discuss the various merits of the materials we use. I recommend you have 6/0 thread, preferably stronger, in white, pink and chartreuse as well as a clear mono thread to use for the day. If you need any more information just call/email me.

The tying styles planned are:

1. **Gotcha style and other Shrimps** – Never mind the bonefish, think bass and mullet on your holidays in the UK. You will need bead chain or similar eyes, white, pale ginger and grizzle hackles, natural brown and white Bucktail or white and tan calf tail, pearl or opal mylar.
2. **Deceiver** – the standard for most Saltwater Streamers large and small. You will need a variety of large hackles in white and grizzle, natural Bucktail, peacock herl, Krystal Flash/flashabou in pearl and light blue and a variety of stick on and weighted eyes
3. **Whistlers** – colourful attractors off the rocky marks for Pollack and for Pike in fresh water. You will need Bead Chain eyes, a variety of large hackles.
4. **Tarpon** – a look at the traditional styles of Tarpon Streamers and the Toad. You will need large black hackles, marabou in black, grizzle and red, fluorescent Fire Orange or chartreuse thread, poly yarn and some large plastic eyes
5. **Maned Flies** – a more modern approach to predator flies. You will need synthetic winging in white, olive, blue and black, Krystal Flash in pearl and light blue, pearl cactus chenille/fritz
6. **Crabs** – a must have if Permit are in the region or if fishing for Bass in rock gullies. You will need Sparkle yarn/Antron in tan, olive, brown and green, rubber legs in at least one similar colour
