NOTES:

1. All anglers must cease fishing not later than the time shown in column 3 above.
No excuses will be entertained for failure to comply with this requirement.
2. Health and Safety. Members should not trout fish after dark. The light fades earlier at some sites and the above times represent the latest time members are permitted to trout fish. There will be occasions where earlier finishing times are more appropriate irrespective of the printed times.
3. Where gates are fitted at Ogston Car Parks those gates **lock automatically at 22.30**.
Please note that whilst you cannot enter the car parks when the barriers are closed they should open to let you out as you drive towards them.
4. For times of fishing at Ladybower Reservoir please see rules on the back of the map and at the Ladybower Fishery Office.
5. For times of fishing at Foremark Reservoir please see rules on the back of the map and at the Foremark Fishery Office.
6. For times of fishing at Carsington Water please see rules on the back of the map and at the Carsington Water Sports Centre.
7. For times of fishing at Blithfield Reservoir please see the rules on the Official Leaflet available at the reservoir.
8. Toft Newton is open from 7.30 a.m. till dusk.
9. The entrances to Willington, Sutton Lake and Wilne Pool have **height restrictors** in place. If you own a high vehicle you need to check that it will go under the barriers which will be set at 2 metres. The ground can be uneven so extra care will be required. If your **only** vehicle is higher than 2 metres you will need to contact either David Holmes or Ron Trevis to discuss the situation.

River Derwent – Allestree, Willersley Castle, Wenslees. River Dove - Church Mayfield.	Floating and sinking Lines with droppers.	Dry, wet, nymph Maximum hook length 2 cm Maximum fly length 2.5 cm
River Dove at Crowdecote & Wolfscote Dale. River Manifold. River Ecclesbourne	Floating lines only with no droppers.	Dry, Nymph, North Country Spiders Maximum hook length 2 cm Maximum fly length 2.5 cm

Lengths given are overall lengths and include the eye of the hook and the tails of flies.

During the Mayfly season Mayfly with no size limit are permitted at Club waters.

Crane Flies (daddy long legs) with no size limit are also permitted.

No additional floats or weights may be added to the fly line or leader.

Sight bobs no more than ¼ inch diameter are permitted but may only be fixed at the junction of the fly line and leader.

A measuring scale for flies is on the back of your Club Membership Card.

Float tubing is permitted only at **Willington Trout Lake and Tiln Lake**.

Strict rules regarding safety and consideration for bank anglers are in place. Members wishing to float tube must contact Alan Patrick for a copy of the rules and booking procedures. No one may float tube without Alan's consent, which will be dependent on **safety requirements** being fulfilled.

Coarse Fishing at Willersley Castle and Church Mayfield.

This is only permitted during to close season for brown trout and with **one rod only**.
If you are catching lot of out of season trout – please move to another swim.

Wading on the River Manifold is not permitted from November to March Inclusive.

Reminders

General

All recognised and accepted methods of fishing for coarse fish are allowed on the Club's Coarse Fishing Waters.

Fish Finders may not be used on waters where a match is to take place for up to one hour before the match starts.

Bait boats may be used **except** at Wilne Pool.

Checking Stations

At Wilne Pool, River Derwent at Allestree and Martyn's Lake, Willington, members must sign in before fishing and record their catch before leaving the site.

Care of Fish

Many societies give help and advice on certain species of coarse fish. Most of these societies have a web site. Some of these are listed below. If you intend to fish for barbel, pike, carp etc. we recommend that you look on the appropriate web site for information on care and handling of these fish, some of which grow very big.

Taking of Pike

All Pike weighing 8 lbs. (3.5kg) or more must be returned carefully to the water in which they were caught.

Night Fishing for Coarse Fish

Night Fishing is permitted only on the River Derwent at Borrowash, Wilne Pool, the River Trent at Willington and Willington Coarse Lake.

The maximum number of consecutive nights a member may stay for is **two**.

Members must sign in on each day they are at the water where there is a checking station. At Willington members must leave their club numbered disc on a hook in the coarse fishing checking station .

APPENDIX 4

Guests and Children / Grandchildren – Procedures

For full details please see
Rules Governing Conduct and Fishing Practices 9 & 10.

Guests.

1. Members are allowed to take **one guest per day to one club water** subject to the maximum of six per season. At Ogston Reservoir more than one guest may be taken on one day provided that guest tickets are completed for each guest. **A guest ticket must be completed when taking a guest to any club water, including the Club's coarse fisheries other than the Lower Derwent (Borrowash to Sawley), the River Idle and the Chesterfield Canal.** A guest ticket must however be used if taking a guest **night fishing** on the Lower Derwent.
2. **Guest tickets.** Members should complete a guest ticket *before starting fishing*. The date and the name of the water should be written in ink on the ticket. ***This ticket must be clipped to a checking station hook before fishing*** or, where there is no checking station, be carried by the guest while fishing. Please see Rules Governing Conduct and Fishing Practices – Rule 9 - for full details. Guest tickets are not transferrable to other members.
3. **Guests and children fishing.** If you take a guest or child to any club water and all the rods are taken, the guest or child may fish even though that exceeds the rod limit for that water. The guest's ticket, or child's disc must be left in the checking station on one of the pegs specifically provided. These are labelled 'Guests & Children'. The member may not fish until another angler checks out and leaves a vacant rod. The member may then sign in and fish.
4. Any fish caught by a guest or child shall be deemed to have been caught by the member and will be counted against the member's catch. ***Please note that, when taking a guest, or child you may only kill one brace of fish between you and NOT one brace each.***
5. **Returning Guest Tickets in checking stations.** Where there is a checking station or hut, members should leave guest tickets in the box provided, when they complete their catch return (including the guest's) and sign out.
6. **Returning Guest Tickets by post.** Where there is no checking station, guest tickets must be returned to the Club Fisheries Secretary. A catch return should be written on the back of the ticket.

Six Guest Tickets are issued each year with Club Membership Cards.
They may be used during the year of issue only and are not replaceable.
A valid until date is printed on each Guest Ticket.

APPENDIX 5

Booking, Signing In and Catch Returns

1. **Signing in and out.** At any Club water, where there is a checking station, members must *sign in on arrival* and *complete their catch return in the book* when signing out. You must write your name in the catch return book clearly and in capital letters and enter your correct club number. A sample of the correct way to complete your catch return is printed on the first page in the book.

Where there is no checking station members may fish without booking in.

2. **Rod Limits and Catch Returns.** Where rods are limited, members should place their *numbered disc* (and child's disc or guest ticket if needed) on a hook in the checking station or hut and complete the forms provided to record their visit and enter their catch or nil return. Any member who exceeds the rods available through the checking station system will be suspended and liable to subsequent expulsion. The number of hooks in the checking station represents the number of rods available.

If there is no spare hook, do not fish (but see also Appendix 4 and Rules Governing Conduct and Fishing Practices – Rule 9 & 10.

3. **Catch Returns.** If there is **no** checking station, a catch return is not required.
4. **Ladybower Reservoir.** Members wishing to book one of the Club's rods on Ladybower Reservoir should telephone the Fishery Office - **01433 651 254** between **7 a.m. & 5 p.m.** Members must collect a catch return form from the fishery office and complete and post it in one of the catch return boxes after fishing. No further booking will be accepted from members failing to do this. Members may not fish at Ladybower more than twice in one week. No guests or children are allowed on our Club tickets but they may be paid for at the Fishery.
5. **Foremark Reservoir.** Members wishing to book one of the Club's rods on Foremark Reservoir should telephone the Fishery Office – **01283 703 202** during office hours. Members must report to the lodge before fishing and complete a catch return there before leaving. No further booking will be accepted from members failing to do this. No guests or children are allowed on our Club tickets but they may be taken & paid for at the Fishery Office. See also Appendix 6. Members may only make one booking in advance, by telephone and may not fish more than twice in one week. *If you have made a booking you may not book another rod until the day after you have fished and completed your catch return.*
6. **Carsington Water.** To book one of the Club's rods on Carsington Water members should telephone the Watersports Centre – **01629 540 478**. You must collect a catch return form and rules from the Centre before fishing and return the completed catch return form before leaving. No further booking will be accepted from members failing to do this. Members may not fish more than twice in one week at Carsington. No guests or children are allowed on our Club tickets but they may be paid for at the Fishery Office. See also Appendix 6.
7. **Blithfield Reservoir.** To book one of the Club's rods at Blithfield, members should telephone the Blithfield Anglers Office on 01283 840284. The office is open from 9 a.m. till 5 p.m. on weekdays and from 9 a.m. till 1 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays. Members must book in using the Blithfield system and must record their catch by completing and submitting fishing return cards before leaving Blithfield. No further booking will be accepted from members failing to do this. Members may not fish at Blithfield more than twice in one week. No guests are allowed on our Club tickets but a member's child/grandchild may be taken and will share the member's catch. *When taking a child the member MUST book a rod for the child using the member's child disk number.*
8. To book rods on the River South Esk. Please contact **Mr Alan Patrick, 24 Westleigh Avenue, Kingsway, Derby DE22 3BX. Tel. 01332 383501**
9. **River Mawddach.** Members wishing to book one of the Club's rods on the River Mawddach should telephone Ron Trevis – 01246 851571. No guests or children are allowed on our Club tickets.
10. **Toft Newton.** To book one of the Club's rods at Toft Newton members should telephone the Toft Newton Fishing Lodge on 01673 878453 or 07806 400878. Members must book in at the lodge and complete a catch return before leaving. No further booking will be accepted until this is done. Float tubing is permitted at Toft Newton. No guests are allowed on our Club tickets but they may be taken and paid for at the Fishing Lodge. A member's child/grandchild may be taken and will share the member's catch. *When taking a child the member MUST book a rod for the child using the member's child disk number*

Note: only one booking may be made at a time on the reservoirs and booking is by telephone only.

When booking give your club number as well as your name.

For bookings a week is counted from Sunday to the following Saturday.

Matches, special events etc. are not included in our rented rods.

The reservoir rods are intended as a bonus to members and not as a cheap substitute for a season ticket.
